The UAE will never cease endeavoring to support women position locally and internationally. Thus, the May 2015 cabinet decision came to form 'UAE Gender Balance Council' regarding all fields of work.

The council endeavors to reduce gender gap and create balance in decision-making centers in conjunction with the UAE vision to be amongst the top 25 countries with regard to gender equality by 2021.
